<i>2nd Alarm</i> Structure Fire	4 Engines 2 Trucks 1 MED Incident Command Post (ICP)	Car 3
<i>3rd Alarm</i> Structure Fire	3 Engines 1 Rescue CAIR1 (Station 35)	1 Battalion Chief RECALL - 1 Deputy Chief (C3A) 2 Battalion Chiefs (B30, B31)
<i>4th Alarm</i> Structure Fire	3 Engines	
<i>5th Alarm</i> Structure Fire	3 Engines	

The following high-rise and target hazard dispatching protocols are also in effect.

<i>High-rise 1</i>	4 Engines 4 Trucks 2 MEDs 1 Rescue ICP CAIR1 (Station 35)	4 Command Officers (Battalion Chiefs, Car 3)
<i>High-rise 2</i>	4 Engines 4 Trucks 2 MEDs 1 Rescue	4 Command Officers
<i>High-rise 3</i>	4 Engines 4 Trucks 2 MEDs	2 Command Officers
